

# JOB OFFER U13-U18 COMPETITIVE COACH

**Position Title:** U13-U18 competitive coach **Reporting To:** Director of Competitive teams

Status: Employee

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Club is seeking passionate and interested applicants to fill various head coaching positions in the competitive programs at Ottawa TFC. The positions will primarily train out of Millennium park and surrounding neighbourhoods, and play games across the national capital region in EODSA sanctioned leagues of various levels. The position seeks a strong communicator, with a sports (ideally soccer) background, and strong leadership and teaching skills. Access to a vehicle is also an asset for this job, though not required. The position is primarily outdoors, and you will be working in all weather conditions.

## **Training/Game Responsibilities**

Attending and running all training sessions for the team(s) you are responsible for. Typically the commitment is 2 practices per week plus a game, for the duration of the season.

- Attending a training session includes:
  - **o** Arriving at least 20 minutes prior to the start of each training session.
  - Reading and understanding all session plans prior to arriving.
  - **o** Wearing OTFC attire whenever on the field.
  - **o** Coordinating via email or phone with supervising coaches at least 48 hours prior to missing any sessions.
  - **o** Preparing session plans whenever asked to do so.
  - o Following OTFC Principles of Play and Game Model.
- Attending a game includes:
  - Preparing and running a proper warm-up for the team (30 mins prior to kick-off)
  - **o** Wearing OTFC attire whenever on the field.
  - **o** Adhering to the technical and ethical standards expected by Ottawa TFC as outlined by the coaches' code of conduct and the Technical Director.

## **Other Responsibilities**

- Assist with player evaluations and feedback throughout the season.
- Attend coaches' meetings if/when required.
- Coordinate one Community Outreach team event during the season, as approved by the Technical Director.



## Qualifications

- Must possess strong written and oral communication skills
- Must have, or be willing to obtain all minimum requirements for coaching at the competitive level in Ontario. Typically this is a weekend coaching course, plus about 8 hours of various online courses and modules.
- Ability to work alone and as part of a team
- Strong planning and organizational skills
- Playing and coaching experience are an asset.
- Experience working with volunteers
- First Aid and CPR is an asset
- Experience working in a Soccer Club environment is an asset
